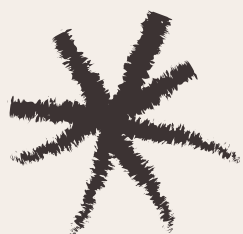

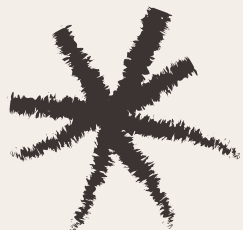

6. What advice would you give to someone who is going to become a sibling for the first time?

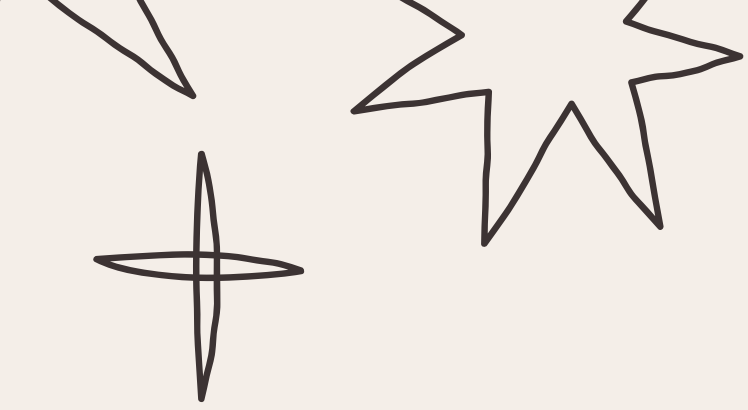

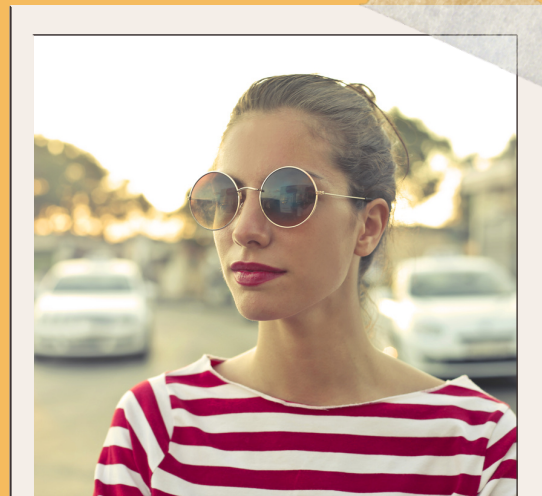

# WHO WOULD YOU LIKE TO BE YOUR SIBLING? WHY?



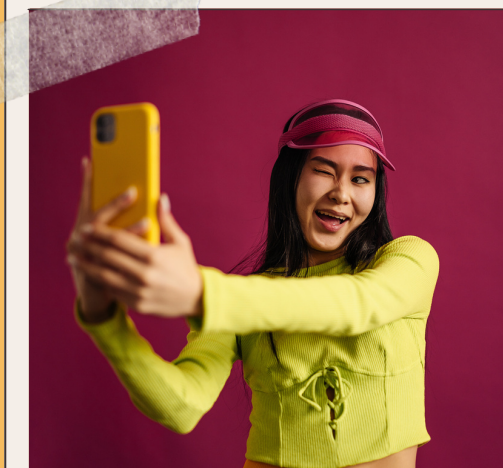
SOPHIE
